By this Addendum, please be advised that the following modifications are made and included in the bid manual dated December 18<sup>th</sup>, 2023. All other requirements of the original Contract Documents and Specifications shall remain effective in their respective order.

**MODIFICATIONS**

Section: Invitation for Bids

The closing date for the submission of bid documents has been extended to February 19<sup>th</sup>, 2024. Consequently, bids will be publicly opened and read aloud on February 20<sup>th</sup>, 2024.

Section: BID FORM

“Construction contingency” has been changed to “Owner allowance”.

“Builder's risk insurance” has been removed from all bid forms.

“Payment and Performance Bond” has been removed from all bid forms.

“Construction fee” has been removed from all bid forms.

“Adjustment of 300 linear feet of 48-inch diameter raw water line and two end connections” bid item has been added to the base bid form. This bid item has been added to cover the cost of relocating the existing 48” raw water main should it be required once the city finalizes its evaluation of the main.

## **PLAN REVISIONS**

Revised bid plan can be found on [Port Muskogee](#) website as attachment B. The following modifications are made and included in the bid plan dated December 18<sup>th</sup>, 2023.

General note clarified protection of ditches that are not delineated to be demolished (see CD sheet series).

Keynote clarified scope of work for pipe installation underneath rail (see CD sheet series).

Keynote clarified demolition of fencing to nearest post, and protection of fences to remain (see CD sheet series).

Demolition of concrete ditch updated from dashed line to demo hatch (see sheet CD106).

Northings and Eastings were added to the proposed concrete ditch (see sheets CI107, CI108, CI112, and CI113).

Approximate delineation and callout of 48" raw water line was added (see sheets VF110, CD110, CI110, and CG110).

Approximate fill quantity information added for each site being raised (see CG sheet series).

## **CONTRACTOR QUESTIONS**

Q1. Does the Contractor have to use dredge material? Can we import all material from offsite?

- Response: The contractor does not have to use dredge material. If they choose not to use the dredge material, the line item in the bid forms should be zeroed out, and the quantity for imported material should be updated to reflect total fill quantity for that bid option.

Q2. How do you keep quantities on dredge fill?

- Response: The Port's surveyor will be surveying the dredged material to determine the quantity.

Q3. How do we test for dredged material if used?

- Response: See addendum #1. Testing shall be in accordance with 2019 ODOT standard for borrow material per section 202.02.

Q4. If dredging material is used, how much cohesive material do you want to cap the sand that gets dredged?

- Response: 8" of topsoil for grass growth.

Q5. Is the project Tax Exempt? Page 21 13 4 2.02 #1 & #2 are conflicting

- Response: The project is tax exempt, and the Port will provide documentation upon award.

Q6. Do we need a dredge permit (404)?

- Response: No, the dredging is considered maintenance under the existing Corp permit, and no additional permits are required for the dredging.

- Q7. Does Prime Contractor need any special insurance like Lond Shoreman Waterway insurance or just the dredging contractor?
- Response: No special insurance is required of the prime contractor. The dredge contractor will need to carry special insurance.
- Q8. Will weather days be considered?
- Response: Yes, weather days will be considered.
- Q9. Does the owner want Aqua Fence installed or stored?
- Response: The Aqua Fence will be stored on-site. The contractor will layout and install the concrete anchors prior to storing.
- Q10. Can we get a summary of concrete paving to be removed?
- Response: The square yardage of concrete paving being removed is as follows:
    - Base Bid (Tract A, Berm) – 0 SY
    - Bid Option 1 (P-Yard) – 155 SY
    - Bid Option 2 (Tract D) – 0 SY
    - Bid Option 3 (Warehouse) – 0 SY
- Q11. How did the quantities get calculated, last job was 300,000 cy and it turned into 107,000 cy because they used satellite to calculate contours, was there a Topo done?
- Response: A topographic survey was completed by HUB Engineers, and the existing surface and proposed surface were compared to determine the amount of fill needed to raise the sites.
- Q12. Construction contingency? Has no value?
- Response: The construction contingency has been changed to owner's allowance. See attached bid form.
- Q13. Construction Fee, what is this for?
- Response: Construction fee has been removed from all bid forms.
- Q14. Need dirt work summary tract A, D, P-yard, Liquid Feed.
- Response: The approximate total fill to raise each of the sites is as follows:
    - Base Bid (Tract A, Berm) – 573,049 CY
    - Bid Option 1 (P-Yard) – 305,546 CY
    - Bid Option 2 (Tract D) – 351,530 CY
    - Bid Option 3 (Warehouse) – 46,383 CY
  - Proposed digital grading information for bidding purposes can be found on [Port Muskogee](#) website as attachment A.
- Q15. At what frequency does the testing of the dredge material need to be completed?
- Response: The dredge material only needs to be tested once by the contractor. All in-place testing will be completed by the owner's Geotechnical Engineer.

Q16. Is Port Muskogee or the contractor going to hire a surveyor to determine final build quantities?

- Response: Port Muskogee will hire a surveyor.

The Contract provides for raising five undeveloped sites above the 100-year flood elevation, constructing a berm to mitigate flooding, installing removable flood-walls to protect existing infrastructure in the event of a flood, and repairing an existing drainage system.

The Work shall be Substantially Completed within Two hundred and seventy (270) calendar days after the date when the Contract Times commence to run as provided in the GENERAL CONDITIONS and completed and ready for final payment in accordance with the GENERAL CONDITIONS within Three hundred and thirty (330) calendar days after the date when the Contract Times commence to run.
  - B. Bidder accepts the provisions of the Agreement as to liquidated damages in the event of failure to complete the Work within the times specified in the Agreement.
